Oskar is a seasoned educator with experience of teaching and senior leadership in the UK and Uganda for over 25 years. He is the Principal of Taibah International School (TIS), an over-subscribed private school with three branches in Kampala, Uganda. Taibah students and alumni exemplify the schools' values of 'independence of approach in the pursuit of excellence in all activities' as well as 'concern for community.'

Outside of his work, he has coached and mentored several schools offering trainings, setting up structures and advising on strategic and development plans. He is also a former part-time lecturer in the Institute of Languages at MUK.

He is a board member of Teach for Uganda (TFU) who have impacted over 90,000 children in rural Uganda (<https://teachforuganda.org>).

Oskar is a socio-political talk show host on national radio with Capital Radio and a former television presenter of NBS FaceOff, a current affairs interview program on NBS TV.

He is a co-founder of Kigo Thinkers (www.kigothinkers.org), a public policy think tank that has published two papers on education in Uganda. He is a Rotarian; a past president of the Rotary Club of Kampala North. He is a fellow of the African Leadership Initiative (www.ali-ea-foundation.net) and a member of the Aspen Global Leadership Network (www.aspeninstitute.org) Oskar has an MA in Education from Brunel University of West London and a BA from Makerere University.
