- 6. He served as the Principal Administrative Secretary to the Ssaabataka's Supreme Council (the precursor to the Great Buganda Lukiiko) from 1991 to 1994 and became a member of the Great Buganda Lukiiko from 1994 to 1995
- 7. He has been involved either directly or by virtue of his different roles within the Kingdom, in the starting of a number of Kingdom organizations and companies namely, CBS FM; BUCADEF; Buganda Land Board; K2 Telecom among others.
- 8. He has received awards locally and internationally for his service to the community in Buganda, Uganda and the Diaspora.
