







Mrs. Esther Kalimuzo - Wife to Mr Frank Kalimuzo

Mrs. Esther Kalimuzo was born on 11th June, 1935 in Gahini, Rwanda to Reverend Elisa Rwabuhungu and Tereza Rwabuhungu. She got married to Frank Kalimuzo on 4th October, 1958. Together, they had six children namely, Daniel, Annette, Phyliss, Rosalind, Grace and Paul Milton.

Who is Esther Kalimuzo?

- 1. Esther Kalimuzo started her education at 10 years, in Gahini Primary School doing Primary 1 and 2, from 1945 to 1946.
- 2. In 1947, she went to Kigeme to do Primary 3 and 4. She was later transferred to Shira Primary in 1948 where she studied P.5 at the girls section and was transferred to the boys section because of brilliance to do P.6.
- 3. Esther trained to be a Primary teacher at Ecole de'monteri from 1951 to 1955. Upon graduation she taught pupils from Kindergarten up to Primary five.
- 4. At 20 years in 1955, she started her teaching career, at Kigeme teaching primary five for one year. In 1956, She was later transferred to Butare to teach Primary four.
- 5. Esther Rwabuhungu met her husband in 1956 in Rwanda at the Golden Jubilee celebrations of the then King of Rwanda.
- 6. On 4th October, 1958 she got married to Frank Kalimuzo at St. James Cathedral Ruharo, Mbarara and started living in Uganda.
- 7. Upon relocation to Uganda, her teaching career was halted because she only spoke Kinyarwanda and French.
- 8. In 1971, Esther trained as Secretary for one year and immediately landed a job in Tumpeco as Secretary to the Assistant Manager.
- 9. In 1973, she worked at Sabena Airlines for 9 months as a Secretary and later resigned to take care of her children.
- 10. When Frank Kalimuzo was kidnapped by the Idi Amin government, she ventured into the business world and traded in hoarded commodities (sugar, soap, batteries), a pesi sales agent, tailoring kaunda suites, wholesale trade of molasses for waragi brewing, a boutique at Uganda House to mention but a few.
- 11. In 1980, Mrs. Esther Kalimuzo gave her life to Christ after which she spent the rest of her life serving the church. Her most recent position being Chairperson, Seniors Ministry and Intercessor at All saints Church Cathedral, Nakasero.
