### Prof. Peter Anyang' Nyong'o

Governor, Kisumu County and former Guild President, Makerere University.

- Guild elections took place on October, 10th 1969.
- Mr Peter Anyang Nyong'o emerged triumphant with 1,088 votes.
- Upon victory, Anyang stated, "We must prepare ourselves to become serving citizens."
- Peter Anyang served as Guild for the academic year 1969/70.
- He was awarded a first-class honours degree in political science.
- He obtained his Master's and PhD in 1977 from the University of Chicago.
- Hon. Peter Anyang Nyon'go currently serves as Governor for Kisumu county since 2017.
- He previously served as Senator from 2013 to 2017.
- Peter was Minister of Medical services from 2008 to 2013.
- He also served as a Member of the Kenyan Parliament from 2003 to 2013.
- From October to December 2013, Nyong'o was a Brundtland Senior Leadership Fellow at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health.
- While at Harvard, he taught a course in the Department of Global Health and Population titled "Leadership Development in Global Health and Policy-Making in Kenya: The Case of Four Parastatals."
