She is a former Head, Department of Medicine, and former Dean of the School of Medicine, Makerere University in addition to prior serving on the University Senate and Council at Makerere University.

She is a researcher in the areas of tuberculosis with and without HIV focusing on immune-pathogenesis, tuberculosis immune diagnostics and clinical trials.
